2 EVERY WINTER THE ENDS OF MY FINGERS SPLIT. IT'S PAINFUL AND DEBILITATING. My father and daughter also suffer. I'd appreciate your advice. Penny, Lincoln

● Skin produces oily sebum to keep it moisturised and protected. Your family could produce low levels, or something at home could be causing a reaction. Change your cleaners, detergents and soaps to reduce chemicals (www.natural-house.co.uk). Protect with a barrier cream (Gloves In A Bottle, £4.99, www.giab.co.uk) and try silk gloves (www.dermasilk.co.uk). **Keep hands warm and well moisturised all year**, so that, when winter arrives, they're less vulnerable (Nelsons Hypercal cream, £4.15, Boots). Cracked skin is prone to infection, so wash with antiseptic gel (see above) and try Sudocrem healing cream (Boots, £1.69). Ditch diets and enjoy pure basic foods – meat, fish, vegetables and fruit.
